



Student Covenant – Code of Conduct

A commitment by each student to personal integrity, refusal to accept dishonorable behavior, and support of appropriate consequences for those who violate the Code of Conduct. At the heart of this code is the desire to honor our Lord Jesus Christ, protect the reputation of you, your church, and the ministry, and to provide a godly framework for students to live by for the rest of their lives. (Colossians 3:17)

Conduct Guidelines:

- Demonstrate respect for others and yourself (1Pet 2:17)
- Demonstrate respect for school, church, ministry, and others property; destruction or theft of property will be cause for immediate dismissal (Exo 20:15, Mat 19:18)
- Behave in a responsible manner (1Tim 3)
- Acts of violence towards another student, staff or person on the property will be cause for immediate dismissal (Psa 73:6)
- Drugs, alcohol and tobacco products are forbidden (1Cor 10:23)
- Keep time (1Cor 14:40)
- Attend class regularly (Prov 13:4)
- Be prepared for class (2Tim 3:17)
- Take seriously the course of study (Mat 27:24, Col 3:17)
- Turn in homework on time, any late papers will be reduced 5% per day (2Tim 2:4)
- Any missed exams must be completed on the next class day (1Cor 14:40)
- Cheating or copying will be cause for dismissal (Jam 1:21)
- Disruption of class will not be tolerated (1Pet 1:15)
- Visitors to class must have prior approval from the Director (Heb 13:17)
- Dress appropriately (1Cor 10:31)
- Cooperate with school/ministry officials (1Cor 16:14)
- No request for financial assistance from Called Christians/The Bridge Calvary Chapel staff will be permitted (Gal 6:3-6)
- When there is an unresolved conflict between students that requires mediation from the staff, the resulting decision will be complied with. Failure to accept the decision will be cause for dismissal (Prov 13:10)

Having a desire to honor God, my school, my family, and my friends, I willingly commit myself to a daily lifestyle that reflects honestly, integrity, trust, and respect for God, peers, authorities over me, and all property. I willingly acknowledge that this lifestyle does not condone lying, cheating, stealing, and other dishonorable acts that would bring grief and shame to my God, my school, and myself.
